January 13: Course introduction, operator certification. Math: math review and water works math.

January 27: Groundwater sources; types, construction, source protection. Math: chemical doses, CT values, treatment.

February 10: Surface water: protection, processes and treatment, issues.

February 24: Distribution: piping, valves, hydrants, meters.

March 10: Distribution continued, storage, small system hydraulics, flushing.

March 24: Field trip to water treatment facility, laboratory, and groundwater system.

April 7: Math review, course review.

January 20: Contaminants, sampling. Math: word problems for drinking water issues.

February 3: Groundwater continued. Geology, hydrology, hydrogeology.

February 17: Surface water continued.

March 3: Field trip to water works materials and equipment supplier.

March 17: Monitoring, Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), more about sampling, laboratory analysis.

March 31: System management, public relations, record keeping, water rates, emergencies.
