Legislation – Make Your Opinion Count!



Legislators shape policy that governs much of society, including municipal operations. The following will help you become an effective legislative advocate:

• **ID the Need.** Identify and discuss your need internally as well as with colleagues in surrounding towns. The <u>NH Municipal</u> <u>Association</u> can be very helpful at this and later stages of the process.

• **Meet Local Legislators**. Inform your local <u>Representatives</u> and <u>Senator</u> of your need. Summertime is best for this step.

• **Build Support**. Request your local legislator be Prime Sponsor or identify a colleague to do so. Recruit additional Sponsors from the House and Senate through partnerships. Best outcomes include broad, bi-partisan support.

• **Draft Legislation**. Sponsors and their staff will draft language that becomes a Bill. Stay involved to confirm Bill meets your needs.

• **Testify**. Submit advance written testimony for your Bill, and attend to testify in public, if possible. In clear, concise language explain why the Bill is important and helpful.
